Grading policy for Broadcast Journalism

Grades:

20% Evaluated Videos (Profile or Spotlight Stories Only)-

Each student must submit a reflection along with the completed story video.

Each 9 weeks it is expected that a team will accomplish producing two videos and write two reflections. In addition the video will not be scored if a final script is not submitted. See rubric for scoring videos.

30% Deadlines –

You will be evaluated on your ability to turn in interviews, surveys, rough script notes, and story pitches on time. In addition if you and your team fail to produce a video by the 3:00 PM Wednesday weekly deadline, you will receive a zero for that assignment. All assignments should be submitted to turnitin.com and our Google docs account. Each assignment that has a deadline attached to it will count for a portion of this grade.

20% Tests, Quizzes, and Worksheets –

This includes open book assignments, layout exercises, current quizzes, and unit tests. Tests are weighted more heavily than quizzes and worksheets.

30% PSA's, Sequences, After-School Coverage & Special Projects-

Any work that will be used in the production, but is not considered a segment is included in this category. Some students who are given specific responsibilities for an episode may have more grades for PSA work than they have for exercises in sequence work. Your grade for your portfolio will be included in this category as well.
